### **Boorer Foundation Scholarship FAQ**

#### **What is the Boorer Scholarship?**

The Boorer Scholarship is offered by the Radford College Foundation to support students entering secondary school at Radford College. It aims to recognise potential, commitment and character, while helping families access a Radford education.

#### **Who is the scholarship for?**

The scholarship is open to Year 6 students who will commence Year 7 in 2027. Applicants may be current Radford college student or students external to Radford.

#### **What does the scholarship cover?**

The Boorer Scholarship provides 100% of tuition fees. Scholarships are typically awarded from Year 7 and may continue through to Year 12, subject to ongoing criteria.

#### **How are scholarships awarded?**

Scholarships are awarded based on:

- Student merit and potential
- Demonstrated financial need
- A willingness to contribute positively to school life

The Radford Foundation considers each application holistically.

#### **Does my child need to be academically top ranked?**

No. While academic engagement is important, the Boorer Scholarship also recognises attitude, effort, character and community involvement.

#### **How long does the scholarship last?**

Scholarships are reviewed annually and may continue through to Year 12, provided the student:

- Maintains satisfactory academic progress
- Demonstrates positive behaviour and engagement



- Remains aligned with the values of the College

### **What is the application process?**

The application process generally includes:

1. Completion of the online scholarship application form
2. Supporting documentation (as outlined in the application)
3. Shortlisting by the Foundation
4. Possible interview or further information request

### **When do applications close?**

Application closing dates will be outlined on the Radford College website.

### **Does receiving a scholarship guarantee enrolment?**

No. Families must still meet the College's enrolment requirements. The scholarship process and enrolment process run alongside each other.

### **Can families apply for more than one scholarship?**

Yes, families may apply for multiple scholarships if eligible. Each application is assessed independently.
