Foundation Scholarship FAQ

What is the Radford College Foundation Scholarship?

The Radford College Foundation Scholarship is offered by the Radford College Foundation to support students entering Senior School (Years 11 and 12). The scholarship recognises potential, commitment and contribution, while helping to remove financial barriers to a Radford College education.

Who is eligible to apply?

The scholarship is open to students entering Year 11 in 2027, including:

- Current Radford students
- Students from other schools seeking to join Radford for their senior years

What does the scholarship provide?

The scholarship offers 100% of tuition fees for Years 11 and 12.

How are scholarships awarded?

Applications are assessed holistically, considering:

- Academic engagement and potential
- Personal qualities such as motivation, resilience and leadership
- Demonstrated financial need
- The student's capacity to contribute positively to college life

Does my child need exceptional academic results?

Not necessarily. While students should be committed to their learning, the Foundation values effort, attitude, character and involvement alongside academic performance.

How long does the scholarship last?

Scholarships are typically awarded for Years 11 and 12, subject to annual review.

Continued support depends on:

- Satisfactory academic progress
- Positive behaviour and engagement



- Ongoing alignment with college values

What is the application process?

1. Completion of the online scholarship application
2. Submission of supporting documentation
3. Shortlisting by the Foundation
4. An interview or request for additional information, if required

When do applications close?

Closing dates are published on the Radford College website.

Does a scholarship guarantee enrolment at Radford College?

No. Students must still meet Radford College's enrolment requirements. The scholarship and enrolment processes operate concurrently.

Can students apply for more than one scholarship?

Yes. Students may apply for multiple scholarships if eligible. Each application is assessed separately.
